Swedish Warmblood

55 000 riding horses 4000-5000 broodmares covered annually

Breeding objective

Internationally competitive horses in dressage, show jumping or eventing.

Production of eventing horses

Show jumping mares with good gaits are covered by stallions with high percent of Thoroughbred, or vice versa.

Young horse tests (3- & 4-year-old horses evaluated for conformation, jumping & dressage)

Results from eventing not included or tested at young horse test

Eventing data Year of competition: 1970 – 2009 No. of horses: 3800 Trait: lifetime performance in eventing 15% Eventing & Show jumping Eventing & Dressage 47% Eventing & Dressage 22% evaluated at Riding Horse Quality test (RHQT)



Methods

Bivariate BLUP Animal Models:

Eventing – Show jumping Eventing – Dressage

Eventing – RHQT trait (conformation, walk, trot,

canter, rideability, jumping technique, temperament for jumping)

Fixed effects:

sex and birth year (competition) sex, age, event (RHQT)
