# The Strange Situation Procedure (SSP) (Ainsworth & Bell, 1970)

(e.g. Topál et al., 1998; Fallani et al., 2006; Gácsi et al., 2001; Palmer & Custance, 2008)

#### **AIM**


To investigate the reliability of the SSP when assessing attachment between dogs and humans



## SSP test design

Episode (3min)	Familiar person a Stranger	and
1	<b>**</b> + ©	Passive
2	<b>↑</b> + ⊕ + ⊕	Play
3	<b>+ ©</b>	Play
4		Alone
5	<b>17</b> + ©	Reunion
6	+ 😊	Reunion

☺ = Familiar person ☺ = Stranger










#### Method

Between treatment comparison




☺ = Familiar person ☺ = Stranger

12 research beagles (females) HR measures (Polar) Wilcoxon signed rank tests






## **Results: Exploration**

## Results: Greeting behaviour

Dogs initiated more physical contact upon reunion with the

familiar person

Tendencies (*P*=0.06) for dogs to...

- vocalise more
- show more tail wagging and
- express more body shaking

...when reunited with the familiar person compared to when reunited with any of the strangers

Dogs initiated more physical contact with a familiar person. Also, they showed a more intense greeting behaviour at reunion with the familar person, to whom they had an established relationship



# The use of SSP in dog attachment studies...

- Dogs scan off the environment quickly
- Dogs show low stranger wariness
- Independent play levels are low
- More challenging situation to activate the attachment system?
