








Exaggerated features in dogs

German Shepherd







Temperament tests



Recording behaviour

Traditional tests:

- Test of function mimic an actual working situation
- Hunting test, herding test, competition results

Personality tests:

- Behaviour assessment protocols
- Not real-life-situations
- Describe behaviour that may influence function





Heritabilities traditional tests

Trait	h ²
Sound underground	0.06
Passion	0.08
Nose aptitude	0.04
Sound on trail	0.09
Height at withers	0.65
Chest circumference	0.45



Heritabilities personality traits

Trait	NSDTR	R. Ridgeback
Greeting behaviour	0.49	0.45
Curiosity	0.38	0.66
Playfulness	0.03	0.30
Threat	0.34	0.39
Social insecurity	0.34	0.27
"Happy and positive"	0.37	0.47
"Confident and curious"	0.37	0.52


Record indirectly
