








## Background

  - Socio-economic pressure to change agriculture




## Background

- (3) determine what barriers they experience in the transition towards circular agriculture




### Methods

Maximum age of 35 years old


Online survey (summer 2021)

## Results - view on circular agriculture




 Circular agriculture offers a solution for agricultural issues in the Netherlands


#### Frequency of application and interest in farm practices


#### Frequency of application and interest in farm practices






## Results – dairy farm practices

#### Frequency of application and interest in dairy farm practices





- Survey from summer 2021

  - Changed political situation
