## The ClassyFarm IT system


ClassyFarm is an information technology (IT) system of the Italian Ministry of Health for collecting, managing, using and exchanging data on livestock production in Italy

#### ClassyFarm is mentioned in several national legislations


- ✓ **Legislative Decree 136/2022**: national legislation on the prevention and control of animal diseases (implementation of the Regulation (EU) 2016/429)

- ✓ **Decree of the Ministry of Health of the 28 June 2022**: Biosecurity requirements for pig farms
- ✓ **Decree of the Ministry of Health of the 30 May 2023**: Biosecurity requirements for poultry farms



#### The biosecurity assessment protocol

- 1. Right apiary identification
- 2. Identification of the single beehive
- 3. Apiary access control
- 4. Provision, control and hygiene of the personal protective equipment available to visitors
- 5. Control and management of new bees introduced into the apiary
- 6. Hive cleaning practices
- 7. Cleaning practices for work tools and personal protective equipment
- 8. Replacement of brood comb
- 9. Separate management of sick colonies
- 10. Origin of beekeeping equipment and wax
- 11. Waste material management
- 12. Varroa infestation monitoring
- 13. Presence of abandoned beehives, apicultural equipment or dead colonies in the apiary
- 14. Control of insects and rodents





"Strong interconnection with the environment."




